Did you know?

- Media are means of communication (radio, television, newspapers, magazines, and the Internet) that reach
 or influence people widely.
- In the United States, an estimated 196 million people used social media in 2016, a number forecast to exceed 216 million by 2021. Facebook accounts for about 42% of all social media site visits in the country.
- In 2019, it is estimated that there will be around 2.77 billion social network users around the globe, up from 2.46 billion in 2017.
- There are major differences in use of social media by age: 88% of 18 29 year-olds; 78% of 30-49 year-olds; 64% of 50-64 year-olds; 37% of 65+year-olds.
